## Learning Conferences

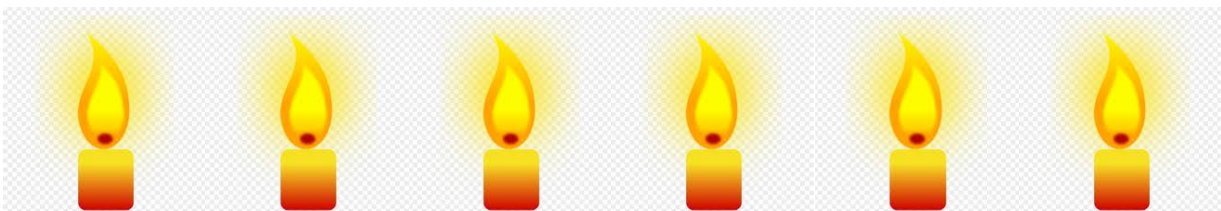
