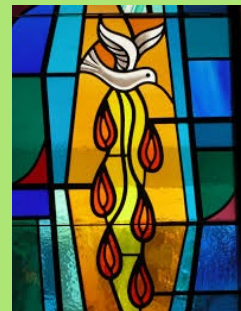

Mufti Day

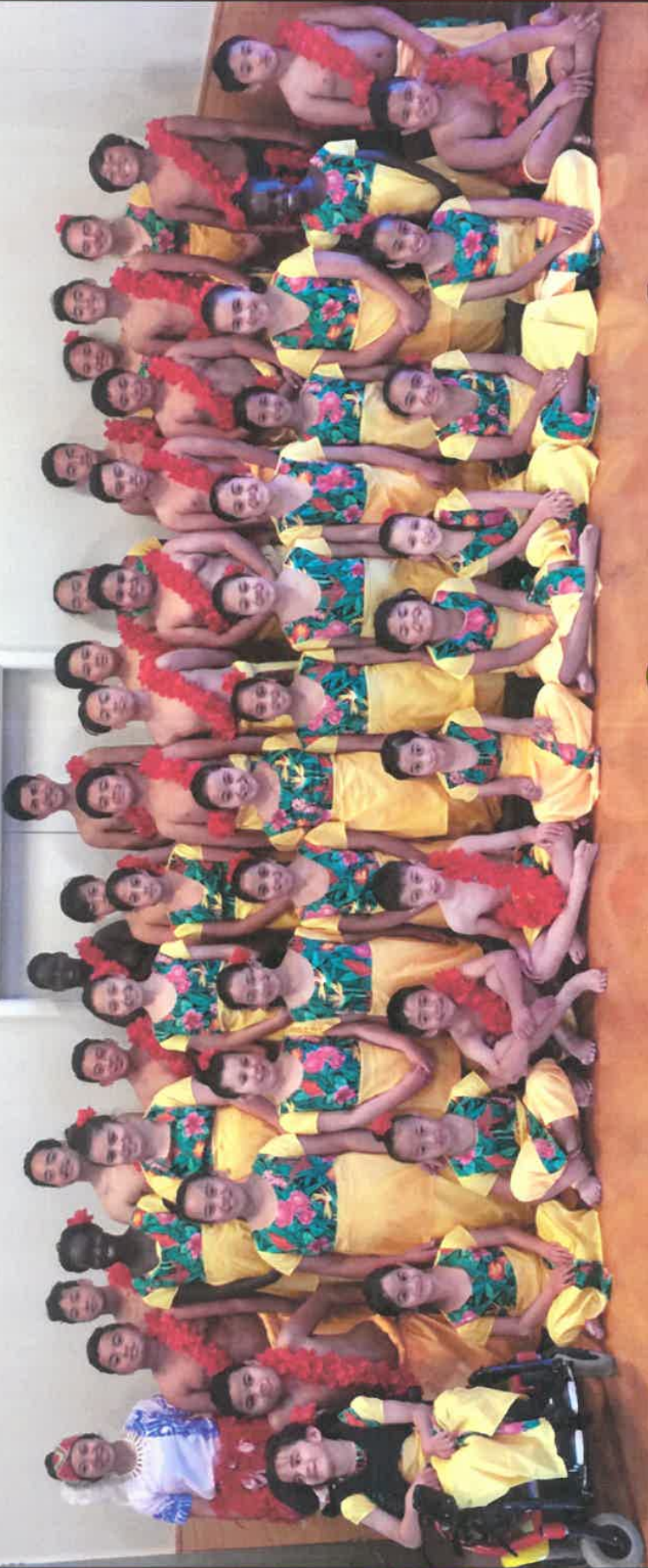
