Netball News – No games this Saturday 2 June and Monday 4 June due to the Queen's Birthday weekend.



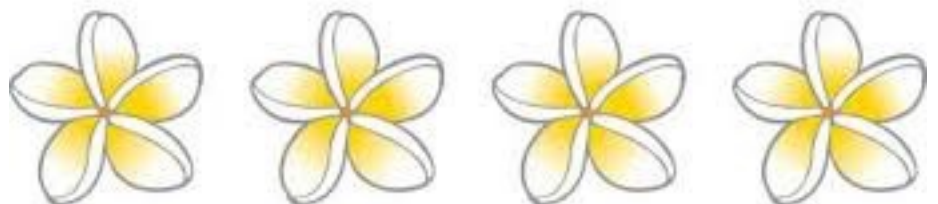
Central Cross Country Event

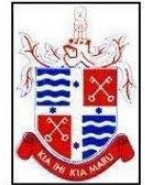
