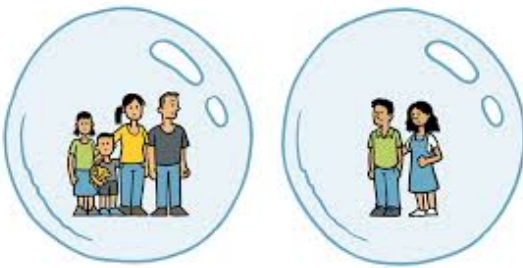

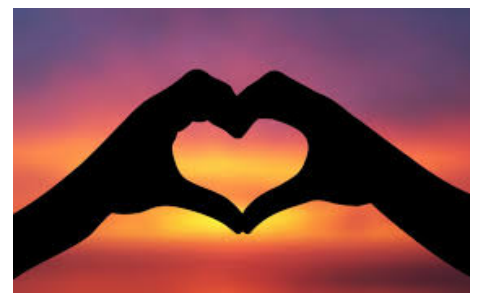


Even though it has officially been holidays teachers have been thinking and working to figure out what will come next for you all learning at home.
